



VISITOR POLICY

Tephra Institute of Contemporary Art is a private property open to members of the public. When visiting, you agree to adhere to the Visitor Policy outlined below. Any individual who, in the Gallery staff's sole determination, fails to observe these policies may be asked to leave the premises and/or restricted from future visits.

- All visitors must be courteous to and respectful of others while visiting. Perceived illegal or threatening behavior to visitors and staff is prohibited.
- Hazardous materials and weapons are not permitted in the Gallery.
- Pets are not allowed to enter the gallery. Service animals are welcome.
- Please be respectful of the art. DO NOT TOUCH.
- All minors under 13 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Certain exhibitions, events, or experiences at the Gallery may have unique rules or requirements to be observed by patrons as specified.
- Posted and announced hours must be observed.
- Gallery visitors may be photographed, videotaped, or otherwise recorded for archival, documentary, publicity, advertising, or other purposes. By attending, you grant Tephra ICA permission to use photographs and/or audiovisual recordings in which you appear for archival, documentary, publicity, advertising, or other purposes.
- The Gallery is monitored using surveillance cameras. The cameras create digital video archives to retrieve and review in the event of Gallery damage, vandalism, or violations of the Visitor Policy.
