# HONORING JUDITH FORST

## Founder of the Tephra ICA Arts Festival



This year, as the Festival turns 35, Tephra ICA is excited to honor artist, curator, and former Executive Director of Tephra ICA, Judith Forst.

The founder of the Tephra ICA Arts Festival, her work and vision cemented our continued mission of celebrating the importance of art in our community. As we mark this milestone, we pause to recognize its dynamic history and the person who launched our largest community engagement program.

Forst studied art at UCLA, the DeCordova in Massachusetts, the Corcoran, and American University. She was Executive Director of Tephra ICA (formerly the Greater Reston Art Center or GRACE), from 1975 to 1980 and again from 1990 to 1995. In 1998, inspired by Aboriginal art from around the world, Judith began studying with Michele Cassou, artist and author of *Life, Paint, and Passion*. She started teaching her own vibrant and personal version of Intuitive Painting out of her home studio from 2001 through 2017. Her work, along with her students' work, was highlighted in the exhibition *Intuitive Painting: Three Generations* in February 2025.

To celebrate and honor her significant contributions, Tephra ICA has instituted the new Judith Forst People's Choice Award at this year's Festival. Visitors will be able to vote for their favorite artist, and the winner will receive a monetary award. Look for signage throughout the Festival to vote for your favorite artist.

## About the Jurors



**DR. LAUREN P. DAVIDSON** is an independent art curator and founder of Museum Nectar Art Consultancy, a practice dedicated to African Diasporic art and to elevating emerging and mid-career artists. Her curatorial work centers on fostering meaningful dialogue around the breadth and complexity of the

Black experience through contemporary art. Davidson has curated a range of noteworthy exhibitions, including the critically acclaimed *Solace & Sisterhood*, presented at the Museum of Contemporary Art Arlington (2024) and the University of Maryland's David C. Driskell Center (2025), featuring artists Evita Tezeno, Amber Robles-Gordon, and Lavett Ballard. Additional projects include *[IR]REVERENT* at the DC Arts Center (2025), *Chosen Family* at the Brentwood Arts Center (2024) and joint exhibitions *The Ties That Bind* and *Zero Dollar Bill: The Prints of Imar Lyman* at IA&A at Hillyer in Washington, D.C. (2022). Alongside her curatorial work, Davidson leads a successful art advisory practice, assisting both private and corporate clients in acquiring exceptional artwork for their collections. She is an active member of the local arts community, collaborating with organizations including Tephra ICA, the IA&A at Hillyer Advisory Committee, and the D.C. Commission on the Arts and Humanities. A multihyphenate academic, Davidson holds a Bachelor of Science from Cornell University and a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine from the University of Florida. She has built a distinguished career in biomedical research over the past two decades and recently completed her Master of Arts in Museum Studies at Johns Hopkins University in support of her curatorial endeavors.
